Welcome to St Luke's.

We are very pleased that you are considering being added to the electoral roll of the church. The electoral roll is a list of names and addresses of people who see themselves as part of the community at St Luke's.

If you are on the roll you can vote at the annual parochial church meeting, and you are able to be nominated, and to nominate others, to hold office in the church, as a member of the parish council (the PCC), a churchwarden or to represent the church at the deanery synod.

It is also a requirement that you be on the roll if you wish to be married at St Luke's but do not live in the parish.

You are allowed to be on the electoral roll of more than one church, but you are only allowed to vote in church affairs at one of them, so you have to choose which that will be.

It is required that electoral roll be renewed every six year, when everyone is asked to reapply.

Being on the electoral roll of St Luke's is one simple way of identifying with this community. We hope you'll decide to join us.

To qualify for admission to the electoral roll, you need to be baptized and be at least 16 years old.

Every six years the electoral roll needs to be renewed, and everyone has to reapply to be placed on the roll.
